

## The Remy Class IV Laser for Pain Management

When the laser is placed against the skin, photons of light penetrate deeply into tissue and accelerate cellular reproduction and growth.

This energy results in the restoration of normal cell function. The main goal of laser therapy is to stimulate the cell to perform its natural functions, but at an enhanced rate.

Class IV Lasers increase the formation of new capillaries in damaged tissue that speeds up the healing process, closes wounds quickly and reduces scar tissue.

Laser therapy decreases painful swelling because it causes blood vessels to expand, creating a “drainage system” which helps to alleviate inflammation.
